Migraine tracking for the moments when tracking feels impossible.

Auralog is built around a simple idea: capture everything you need in the moment, with every record ready to review or add to whenever you choose. Auralog 27.0 brings that calm, low-effort experience to Apple Watch and deepens its integration with Siri, Shortcuts, widgets, and Live Activities.

WHAT'S NEW

Built into the moments that matter.

- **Apple Watch**
Start, update, and end episodes, add treatments and triggers, and check Risk Outlook from the wrist.
- **Risk Outlook**
Customizable context from recent sleep and local weather, with more sources planned.
- **Natural-language capture**
Auralog helps extract the triggers a person names using Apple's Foundation Models framework where supported.
- **Siri + Shortcuts**
Rich visual results, onscreen awareness, and deeper App Intents for the all-new Siri experience.
- **Useful at a glance**
Widgets, Live Activities, Smart Stack support, and watch complications keep timely information close.
- **Language support**
Auralog supports English, Spanish, French, and Portuguese (Brazil).

Designed for personal insight: Auralog helps people capture and better understand their own migraine history. It is not a diagnostic tool, and Risk Outlook offers context rather than certainty.

THE AURALOG IDEA

Save now. Log later.

Auralog was shaped by founder Adrian Eves's lifelong experience with migraine and the friction of tools that ask people to form a logging habit. When an episode starts, even a simple form can feel like too much.

Auralog separates capture from documentation. One tap records the moment. Severity, treatments, symptoms, possible triggers, and notes can be added on the person's own terms. The result is a calmer record that bends around the user instead of asking the user to bend around the app.

DESIGN PRINCIPLE

The tracker should do the adapting. Not the person in pain.

PRIVACY

People's migraine histories are stored on their devices, not in an Aberfeldy Studios account or database. The developer cannot see what people record, and migraine-entry contents are not included in app analytics.
